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CLUB MEETINGS

Meetings to conduct the business of Conewago Rod & Gun Club are held on the third Wednesday of each month and begin at 7:30pm at the clubhouse. All members are invited and encouraged to attend.

MEMBERSHIP

The use of all club facilities is restricted to members and authorized guests only. Membership is not required for participation in club sponsored events open to the public (i.e. trap, block shoots, etc.) or for individuals who are only observing the shooting activities of a club member.

CLUBHOUSE

The clubhouse is locked except during club meetings, work nights, and shooting matches. Any member may purchase a key to the clubhouse at a regular monthly meeting of the club. See the club president for a key.

RANGE RULES

- 1. No member under the age of 18 may use any range without being accompanied by an adult member.
- 2. All firearms must be brought to the range unloaded except for concealed carry weapons.
- 3. Maximum of 10 rounds may be loaded in magazines, clips, or revolver cylinders.
- 4. No rapid fire at any time. One second between shots.
- 5. If a cease fire is called all firearms must be made safe by unloading them and opening the action.
- 6. No handling of firearms when anyone is down range.
- 7. Paper targets only except for club supplied reaction targets.
- 8. Only members and their guest, with a guest pass, may use the ranges.
- 9. Membership cards must be displayed while using the ranges.
- 10. Do not use ranges if intoxicated. No alcoholic beverages permitted on club property.
- 11. Pick up your used cases, pull your targets, and put any trash in the proper containers.
- 12. Eye and ear protection are required.
- 13. If shooting prone, position targets on the bottom half of the target backers.
- 14. Shoot only at the target in front of you. No cross-firing.
- 15. Paper targets cannot be fastened to the wooden framework.
- 16. Obey posted rules specific to the archery platform and firearm ranges.
- 17. No steel shot may be used on the trap range and shot size on the trap range is limited to 7½ shot or smaller.
- 18. Trap shooting using personal clay bird throwers are to be used at the two middle trap fields (#2 and #3) only.
- 19. Violation of the rules may result in loss of range privileges or membership revocation after an investigation and a majority vote of the members present at a monthly member meeting.

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Shooting is not permitted before 7:00am Monday-Saturday or before 8:30am on Sunday

RANGES

Trap Range (3 trap houses only open during sanctioned shoots and practices); 100 & 200 yard Range; Smallbore & Pistol Range (15, 25, and 50 yard targets); Archery Platform

RANGE CLOSURES

- Work nights are held every Tuesday evening from April to October.
- Ranges may periodically be closed for special events upon approval of the Officers and Directors of the club. In the case of a range closure, notice of the closure will be posted at the ranges and clubhouse with the goal of at least two weeks in advance.

By submitting this application and affixing my signature below I understand and agree to the following:

- ✓ I understand that applications will not be mailed to the club or given to any member or officer of the club prior to the range safety and orientation session. Applications and payment must be brought to the range safety and orientation session. Failure to attend a range safety and orientation session will prevent the club from approving membership.
- ✓ I understand that the membership year is from January 1 December 31 regardless of when I joined during the year. Dues or fees are not pro-rated.
- ✓ I agree to abide by all rules and regulations of Conewago Rod and Gun Club and understand that any violation thereof could result in the suspension or permanent revocation of my membership and the associated privileges as determined by the Board of Directors. I also understand and agree that all dues and fees that I have paid will be forfeit if my membership is revoked for cause.
- ✓ I agree that I am required to purchase a guest pass for a non-member that I wish to bring to the club to use the shooting facilities. The only exception is for events that are open to the public.
- ✓ I agree that I am responsible for ensuring that all members listed in my family membership and all guests using one of my guest passes understand and abide by all rules and regulations of Conewago Rod and Gun Club.
